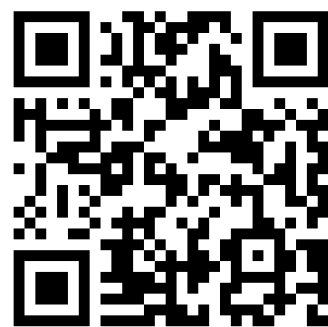

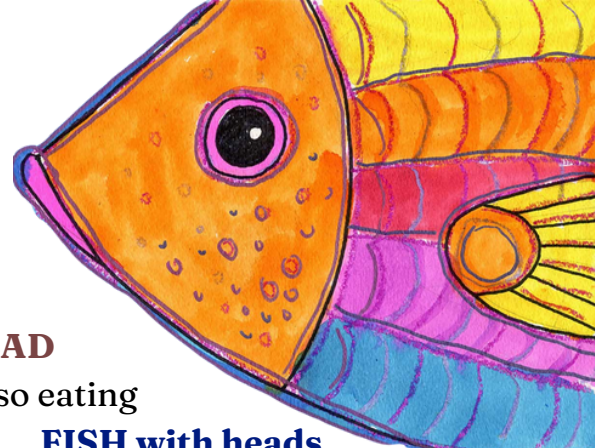

# Childcare Information

- Childcare **SIGN UP** on reverse side -

We are delighted to offer childcare again this year!

Parents will find it easier to support their children's participation in whatever youth-centric services and activities are appropriate for them, without having to bring siblings to programming that isn't geared to them. We also hope childcare will make it easier for parents to factor in their own spiritual needs . . . because the High Holidays are for grown-ups, too.

Parents may bring children to childcare and pick them up according to whatever schedule works for them, including dropping off and picking up their children multiple times over the course of the day.

**For children 6 months to 8 years old,  
we are offering childcare:**

*Rosh HaShanah Day One 10am - 1pm  
Yom Kippur from 9:30am - 12:45pm*

Our High Holiday  
childcare provider is a

**Childcare is only guaranteed if you register by Friday September 12.**

- If you do NOT register in advance, you are welcome to take your child upstairs to ask the childcare provider if they can comfortably take responsibility for your child. They will do so if possible, but we reserve the right to decline if the number of people who wish to drop-off their children proves unwieldy.

**Childcare is being held in the classrooms on the second floor.**

- We regret that the second floor is only accessible by stairs and we regret that there is no wheelchair/stroller accessible location in which we can hold childcare. Childcare will be based in classrooms 207 and 205, although our childcare provider may take the children in their care to the High Holiday children's activity stations in 203.

## Financial Terms

**One Day: 1 child = \$20 / 2 children = \$35 / 3+ children = \$45**

**Two Days: 1 child = \$40 / 2 children = \$70 / 3+ children = \$90**

Each month, **4100 individuals** visit on of the 4 Mitzvah Food Pantries in our area

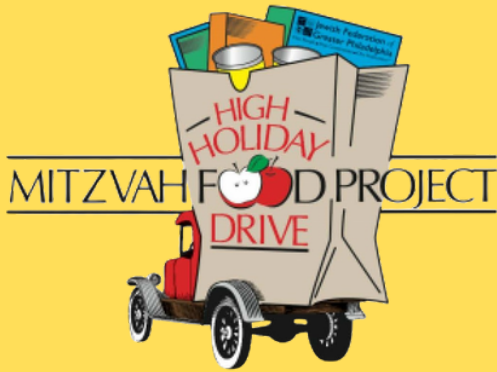
The Jewish Federation's High Holiday Food Drive is our community's largest and most important coordinated food collection effort of the year.

Our beautiful building can sometimes be challenging for people with disabilities, but we are deeply committed to doing everything we can to be **ACCESSIBLE**.

There are designated parking spaces for people with disabilities.

The **Solarium Entrance** to the Building is level, with a **ramp** into the sanctuary and another **ramp** onto the *bima* (stage) and to the rest of the first floor.

We have an upgraded **Sound System** and we also have close captioning on the screens in the Sanctuary & Community room.

We have a private, all gender **Bathroom** that accommodates most people with physical disabilities. We intend to install a more fully accessible bathroom as soon as our resources permit.

The Staircase Art Gallery is always available as a **Quiet Space**

Almost all of our programs are accessible digitally using Zoom.

We test the **AIR QUALITY** in the building regularly. Other than the Solarium, all rooms on the first and second floor are **Air Conditioned**.

As a precaution, we also have **Air Purifiers** in every room.

In the Solarium, we have tools to support those who need **Page Magnifiers** **Basic Masks** **Assisted Listening Devices** for those who are immuno-compromised

We have a **Pray & Play** space for young children at the back of the Sanctuary.

Some chairs in the Sanctuary always have arms and we are happy to reserve seats upon request.
