

5772/2011 High Holiday Parking at Or Hadash

Parking for holidays at Or Hadash can sometimes be a challenge when we have a large number of congregants and guests. Please note that because **all High Holiday services this year will take place at Or Hadash**, we *strongly encourage you to carpool whenever possible to save both energy and space*. Please inform the Laurie Albert, Office Manager, of any **special parking need accommodations** by September 15th. Parking Volunteers will be at Or Hadash to assist you, but please abide by the following important guidelines:

- **Erev Rosh Hashanah evening service (Wednesday September 28th):**
In addition to the parking lot at Or Hadash, we are also permitted to use the parking lots at both Wordsworth Academy and Play N Learn for overflow parking.

- **Rosh Hashanah – first day (Thursday, September 29th):**
 - Carpooling is encouraged.
 - In addition to the parking lot at Or Hadash, we are also permitted to use the parking lot at WORDSWORTH ACADEMY.
 - NO PARKING IS ALLOWED AT PLAY N LEARN.

- **Rosh Hashanah - second day (Friday September 30th):**
Services will take place while school is in session at *both* neighboring facilities. We want to continue to enjoy good relationships with our closest neighbors; please note:
 - NO PARKING IS ALLOWED AT WORDSWORTH.
 - We may be able to use a few open spots at Play N Learn, but please DO NOT USE SPOTS MARKED “PARENTS ONLY”.

- **Kol Nidre evening service (Friday, October 7th) and**
- **Yom Kippur (Saturday October 8th): all services are at Or Hadash.**
In addition to the parking lot at Or Hadash, we are also permitted to use the parking lots at both Wordsworth Academy and Play N Learn for overflow parking. The wooded path from Wordsworth to Or Hadash will be lit at sundown to facilitate using the path after services to return to your vehicle.
