From the JRA Website:

Most volunteers arrive at 10:00am. Volunteers check in, have a quick nosh (bagels and shmeers and coffee, of course!), get a brief orientation and take their place alongside other enthusiastic volunteers in the assembly line packing boxes with food. Packing takes about 90 minutes — it's not a race, but 750+ people working together can get things done really fast.

Volunteers load their cars with 8-12 boxes and make deliveries right to the homes of JRA's recipient families. We make deliveries to recipients who live all over the five county Philadelphia area and northern Delaware, and provide turn-by-turn driving directions so you won't get lost.
