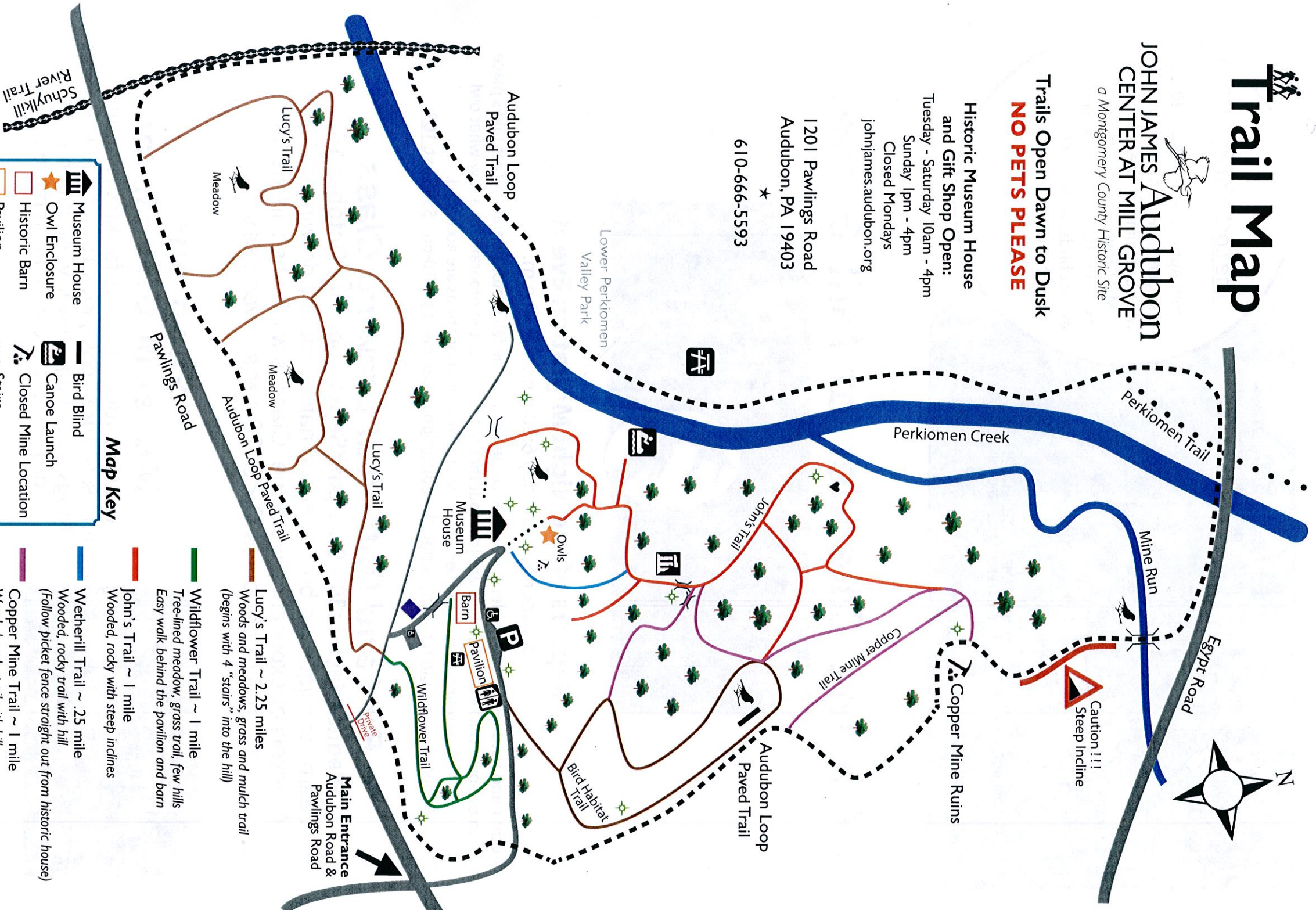

- Lucy's Trail ~ 2.25 miles
Woods and meadows, grass and mulch trail
(begins with 4 "stairs" into the hill)
- Wildflower Trail ~ 1 mile
Tree-lined meadow, grass trail, few hills
Easy walk behind the pavilion and barn
- John's Trail ~ 1 mile
Wooded, rocky with steep inclines
- Wetherill Trail ~ .25 mile
Wooded, rocky trail with hill
(Follow picket fence straight out from historic house)
- Copper Mine Trail ~ 1 mile
Wooded, rocky trail with hill
- Bird Habitat Trail ~ 1 mile
Open meadows, grassy trail
Main entrance off paved drive between white posts
- Audubon Loop Trail ~ 4.5 miles
Paved, some hills, wheelchair accessible
