- **Bring a jacket or sweater if it is wet or cool.**

Directions to Robbins Park (no services or Torah study will be held at Or Hadash)

- Route 309 north to Susquehanna Rd./Butler Pike exit
- Left at the end of the exit ramp onto Susquehanna
- Right at first light onto Butler Pike
- Cross back under Route 309 and turn left into the Robbins Park parking lot (just before the light for Meetinghouse Road, opposite the Temple Ambler parking lot)
- The pavilion will be on your right, down a short path, as you pull into the parking lot (park on your left, so the path will be on the opposite side of the parking lot, behind you)
