DR. DINA LICHTMAN SMITH WAS BORN IN BERGEN BELSEN'S DISPLACED PERSONS CAMP IN 1948. HER PARENTS WERE PRISONERS AT AUSCHWITZ AND MET IN THE DP CAMP AFTER THE WAR. SHE CAME TO THE US AS A REFUGEE IN 1949, WHEN SHE WAS ONLY 18 MONTHS OLD.

DINA AND HER PARENTS WERE SETTLED IN NORTH PHILADELPHIA, ALONG WITH MANY OTHER HOLOCAUST SURVIVORS. DESPITE HER IMPOVERISHED CHILDHOOD, DINA WENT ON TO EARN HER UNDERGRADUATE AND DOCTORAL DEGREES FROM TEMPLE UNIVERSITY.
