

VOLUNTEER ROLES

- Digital Host (from Or Hadash)** – Run the Zoom during one or more of our High Holiday services from the Or Hadash sanctuary; this role includes screen and video sharing, spotlighting, and use of a pre-created slide deck and overlay. If you're a Zoom sort of person, this is the job for you!
- Digital Usher (from your home)** – Greet congregants and guests (using the chat function) as they enter services & programs on Zoom, help with mute/ unmute, periodically post page numbers and other useful information in the chat
- Sanctuary Greeter** – Welcome congregants and guests at the greeter table in the Solarium, check attendance, hand out information
- Sanctuary Usher** – Hand out/return prayer books, offer information, help with seating and logistic, maintain quiet
- Parking Direction** – Get and receive good parking “car-ma” during High Holiday services
- Set Up/ Take Down Team** – Help get our spaces ready before and after the High Holidays. Involves room setup, decorating tables, and transforming our sacred space for the Days of Awe (“shlepping” dates: 9/23 & 10/7 @ 10am)

SERVICE HONORS

- * **Candle Lighting** light and bless the holiday candles at Erev Rosh Hashanah or Kol Nidrei
- * **English Reading** for one person in the Sanctuary
- Lead Erev Rosh Hashanah Kiddush**
- * **English Reading** for two people (i.e.: alternating sections) in the Sanctuary
- Blow the Shofar** on the 1st day of Rosh Hashanah
- * **English Reading** at Family Services
- Blow the Shofar** on the 2nd day of Rosh Hashanah
- * **Open/ Close the Ark**
- (even if you do not have prior experience, everyone is welcome to bring a shofar to the end of Yom Kippur services)
- Carry the Torah through the congregation**
- Lift or Dress the Torah** (prior experience required, circle one)
- Hold a Torah Scroll on Kol Nidrei**
